

### 1 Finding the Kyudojo National de Noisiel


The Kyudojo is located in the town of Noisiel, inside the "Complexe Bernard Légier" which also houses the Tennis Club de Noisiel. **It is about 20km East of Paris center.**

On Google, the address "**NOISIEL, 1, Square du Verger**" indicates the entrance of the complex, which can be reached (150m on foot) from the roundabout at the eastern end of the "Allée de la Ferme" by crossing a small, wooded park.

The **nearest public car park is the Ferme du Buisson car park**, the entrance to which is at the roundabout at the western end of "Allée de la Ferme". The GPS coordinates of this entrance are: 48.844331 N and 2.623008 E.



### 2 Getting there by public transport



The Kyudojo is located near the RER line A.

Major renovation work will be taking place from August 9th to 18th. The RATP will provide a replacement bus, but an alternative route is available via the RER E towards Villiers sur Marne/Le Plessis Trévisse or Tournan, departing from either the Saint-Lazare or Magenta (Gare du Nord) stations (special fare from Paris stations: €5.00).

The Kyudojo is approximately equidistant (about a 15-minute walk) from the NOISIEL and LOGNES stations on the RER line A. These two stations are also connected by bus line n° 211, with a stop named "VERGER" located just in front of the Square du Verger.

### 3 Getting there by private car

Noisiel is located at the intersection of the A4 highway and the Francilienne Sud-Est (N 104) motorway.

#### From Paris:

1. Take the A4 highway at Porte de Bercy, direction: REIMS, METZ, NANCY.
2. After about 17km, leave the A4 on the right, then take the left lane [Val Maubuée Centre / Noisiel - Torcy].
3. Exit to the right towards [Noisiel - le Lizard / Lognes].
4. At the stop sign turn left (Bd du Mandinet). Go straight on at the first traffic lights (Banque de France exit), then in front of the Total station, and at the following traffic lights turn right onto Boulevard Salvador Allende.
5. At the roundabout after the bridge over the railway, turn right onto Cours du Buisson.
6. At the next roundabout turn right into the car park (along the long brick wall of the Ferme du Buisson).
7. Please note: only the first part of the car park is public; the second part beyond the metal fence is private (SuperU) and may be closed by a barrier at certain times.

### 4 Eating

In the immediate vicinity:

- SuperU: supermarket open Monday to Saturday from 9am to 9pm, Sunday from 9am to 1pm
- Royal Noisiel: Asian restaurant, open every day except Tuesday: 11am to 3pm and 5:30pm to 10:30pm
- Relais du Buisson, traditional restaurant in the courtyard of the Ferme du Buisson, open Monday from 12 noon to 2pm (closed in the evening), Tuesday to Friday from 12 noon to 2pm and from 7pm to 9.30pm; closed Saturday and Sunday

A little further away:

- Restaurants and shops near the two RER stations of Noisiel and Lognes

#### **IMPORTANT :**

- The organisers are looking into the possibility of providing meals on site: information to come later.

### 5 Accommodation

Many hotels are located near the RER line A stations, and of course in Paris.

**Only one hotel allows you to go easily to the Kyudojo on foot** (in 15 minutes), it is the Hipotel (<https://hotel-marne-la-vallee.hipotel.fr/>) located near the NOISIEL RER station.

Another interesting location is the TORCY RER station, the next station from LOGNES towards Marne-la-Vallée- Chessy, near which there are half a dozen hotels at reasonable prices, and two shopping and leisure centres: Bay 1 and Bay 2.

A special mention for the **Campanile Hotel in Torcy** (<https://marne-la-vallee-torcy.campanile.com/fr-fr/>) which offers special conditions to 2023 Shinsa and seminar participants. To benefit from a **30% discount on the posted rates**, you must make a reservation with :
